BY THE BOARD:

The New Jersey Board of Public Utilities' (the "Board") SMARTSTART Buildings Program ("SSBP" or "SMARTSTART"), Direct Install Program and Pay-for-Performance Program offer financial incentives to New Jersey property owners to encourage the installation of energy efficient products and technologies. Eligible applicants may receive incentives for a portion of the cost of installing energy efficient technologies such as lighting, HVAC, water heating or other measures in new or existing buildings.

Pavilion Properties, Ltd, Los Angeles, CA, has submitted an application for a monetary incentive in the amount of \$552,782 under the Pay-for-Performance – Existing Buildings program, for a project located at Pavilion Apartments, 108-136 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd, Newark, NJ. The first estimated incentive, for the energy reduction plan (ERP) is \$50,000. The estimated second incentive, for certain measures (including installation of high efficiency hot water boilers, replacement of existing pumps with pumps utilizing variable frequency drive [VFD] motors, and lighting improvements) is \$251,391, and the estimated third incentive for the one year true up of the ERP is \$251,391. This application has an estimated 22% total energy savings and will save the customer an annual estimate of 357,073 kWh of electricity, an annual estimated demand reduction of 57 kW, and an annual estimate of 16,969 MMBtu of natural gas. Overall, this application will have an estimated annual energy cost savings of \$283,891.

TRC, the Market Manager engaged by the Board to manage the New Jersey Clean Energy Program C&I energy efficiency programs, has submitted a certification that the incentive for

which TRC now seeks approval to commit has been calculated in accordance with the program policies and procedures, and that the listed amount is the true and accurate estimated incentive for which the applicant is eligible. Further, Applied Energy Group, in its role as the NJCEP Program Coordinator, has reviewed the application and submitted a certification that the incentive for which TRC now seeks approval to commit has been calculated in accordance with the program policies and procedures, and that the listed amount is the true and accurate estimated incentive for which the applicant is eligible. Based on the above, the Staff recommends that the Board approve the above referenced application.

The Board <u>HEREBY ORDERS</u> the approval of the aforementioned application for the total estimated incentive amount of \$552,782, and <u>AUTHORIZES</u> issuance of a standard commitment letter to the applicant identified above, setting forth the terms and conditions of this commitment.

6. Brief description of measures

Measure #1 — High Efficiency Boilers: Replace current unit serving both towers with three new space heating hot water condensing boilers (87%eff) in each tower. This eliminates the heat loss of underground piping.

Measure #2 – VFD Pumps: Replace existing pumps with a premium efficiency pumps and utilize a VFD motor to better control and match building demands.

<u>Measure #3 – Lighting Improvements:</u> Retrofit T12 to T8s (portion of common areas), Incandescent to CFLs (apartments), Incandescent to LED Edit signs (common areas), and add occupancy sensors, daylight sensors (common areas).
