BEFORE RICHARD McGILL, ALJ:

This matter is a billing dispute between George Boinides and Public Service Electric and Gas Company. The matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law on October 19, 2012, for determination as a contested case.

On the hearing day, the parties agreed to an amicable resolution of the matter and submitted a Stipulation of Settlement. Having reviewed the record and the settlement terms, I **FIND** as follows:

1. The parties have voluntarily agreed to the settlement as evidenced by their signatures or the signatures of their representatives.
2. The settlement fully disposes of all issues in controversy and is consistent with the law.

Therefore, I **CONCLUDE** that the agreement meets the requirements of N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1 and that the settlement should be approved. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the parties comply with the terms of the settlement, and it is **FURTHER ORDERED** that the proceeding in this matter be concluded.

I hereby **FILE** my initial decision with the **BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES** for consideration.

This recommended decision may be adopted, modified or rejected by the **BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES**, which by law is authorized to make a final decision in this matter. If the Board of Public Utilities does not adopt, modify or reject this decision within forty-five (45) days and unless such time limit is otherwise extended, this recommended decision shall become a final decision in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10.

In the interests of good faith and customer relations, and to resolve this matter in a timely fashion, the parties have agreed to settle the dispute.

Without admitting fault to any claims raised in this action, the parties agree to the following terms:

- a) Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("PSE+G") will credit to Petitioner's account for the 2nd floor at 106 Suller Rd., Bloomfield, NJ the amount of \$1,070.82.
- b) Petitioner, George Boinites, will pay to PSE+G \$430.37 for the above-referenced 2nd floor account.
