BY THE BOARD:

By Order dated March 28, 2014, the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board") denied the petition of Fishermen's Atlantic City Windfarm, LLC's ("FACW") for a determination, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:3-87.2, of eligibility as a qualified offshore wind facility as set forth in N.J.S.A. 48:3-87.1 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 14:8-6.5 et seq. The March 28 Order contains the extensive procedural history of this case, which is incorporated herein by reference.

By Order dated April 28, 2014, the Board denied FACW's motion to reopen the proceedings, to supplement the record and for reconsideration.

On May 5, 2014, FACW filed a notice of appeal with the Superior Court of New Jersey, Appellate Division, Docket No. A-003932-13. On June 30, 2014, FACW filed a motion to supplement the administrative record on appeal and to expedite Board findings on the supplemented record.

On August 8, 2014, the Court granted the motion and ordered the Board to complete its findings on the supplemented record within 120 days, and that the Board shall make a good faith effort to complete the remand sooner.

Accordingly, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:2-32, the Board <u>HEREBY DESIGNATES</u> President Dianne Solomon as the presiding officer. The Board <u>FURTHER ORDERS</u> that President Solomon, as the presiding Commissioner, is <u>HEREBY AUTHORIZED</u> to establish and modify schedules, decide all motions, and otherwise control the conduct of this case, without the need for full Board approval, subject to subsequent Board ratification.

The Board <u>HEREBY DIRECTS</u> staff to post this Order on the Board's website and serve a copy of the Order to the service list electronically.

In addition, in the interests of economy, all parties are <u>HEREBY DIRECTED</u> to serve all documents electronically, while still providing hard copies to the Board for those documents which must be filed with the Board, with hard copies to each party upon request.
