BACKGROUND

By Order dated June 21, 2013 ("June 21, 2013 Order"), the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities ("Board") authorized South Jersey Gas Company ("SJG") to construct and operate a twenty-four (24) inch natural gas transmission pipeline ("Pipeline" or "Project") with an approximate 21.6 mile alignment through Maurice River Township in Cumberland County, City of Estell Manor in Atlantic County and Upper Township in Cape May County, subject to certain conditions.

The affected municipalities are located in land use management areas under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Pinelands Commission ("Pinelands Commission"), and are subject to the Commission's Comprehensive Management Plan ("CMP"), set forth in N.J.A.C. 7:50-1, et seg.

On October 20, 2014, SJG filed a petition ("Petition for an Amended Order") with the Board requesting that it amend the June 21, 2013 Order to include two (2) additional provisions. Specifically, the first amendment requested by the Company provided as follows:

Provided, however, that unless ordered to do so by this Board, or other governmental authority having jurisdiction, the Company will not connect any new customer to that portion of the Pipeline within the area designated as the Forest Area pursuant to the CMP.

SJG also requested that the Board approve a change in the location of the point of interconnection and the regulator station from Marshall Avenue in Upper Township to Mount Pleasant–Tuckahoe Road in Upper Township.

The Board issued an Order on July 23, 2015 ("July 23, 2015 Order"), which granted SJG's requests to: (1) preclude new customers from utilizing the Pipeline unless approved by the Board or other governmental entity; and (2) change the location of the point of interconnection and the regulator station. In re the Petition of South Jersey Gas Company for Authorization to Construct a 24" Pipeline Through Maurice River Township in Cumberland County, City of Estell Manor in Atlantic County and Upper Township in Cape May County, New Jersey, Docket No. GO13030202 (Order dated July 23, 2015) at 8. The July 23, 2015 Order contains the extensive procedural history of this matter, which is incorporated herein by reference.

On September 4, 2015, the Pinelands Preservation Alliance filed a notice of appeal of the Board's July 23, 2015 Order with the Superior Court of New Jersey, Appellate Division ("Appellate Division"), Docket No. A-0151-15T1. In a decision issued on November 7, 2016, the Appellate Division affirmed the Board's July 23, 2015 Order, but remanded the matter to the Board for entry of an Amended Order adding the following: "the Board's approval of the pipeline and its construction is conditioned upon the issuance by the [Pinelands] Commission of a final decision finding the that the pipeline is consistent with the minimum standards of the CMP." In re South Jersey Gas Co., 2016 N.J. Super. Unpub. LEXIS 2428, 18 (App. Div. November 7, 2016).

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS

Accordingly, based upon the above, and in conformance with the Appellate Division's ruling, on remand, and pursuant to the provisions of <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 14:7-1.4, the Board <u>HEREBY AMENDS</u> the Board's Order of July 23, 2015 to include the following language:

The Board's approval of the Pipeline and its construction is further conditioned upon the issuance by the Pinelands Commission of a final decision finding that the Pipeline is consistent with the minimum standards of the Pinelands Comprehensive Management Plan (CMP); and

The Board <u>FURTHER ORDERS</u> that the terms and conditions of the Board's prior orders, which are incorporated herein by reference, shall remain in effect, except as modified by this order.
