

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this **6th Day of January, 2015** entered in the amount of \$7,433.50 against Defendant Wallis, and in favor of the Plaintiff, Kenneth E. Kobylowski, Commissioner

of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 et seq. ("Fraud Act"), pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; attorneys' fees of \$1,433.50, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant Wallis's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date hereof.
