

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this **30** day of **March** 2015, entered in the amount of \$9,761.00 against Defendant Luis Pacheco and in favor of the Plaintiff, Kenneth E. Kobylowski,

Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of a \$5,000.00 civil penalty pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b for one (1) violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 et seq.; attorneys' fees of \$3,761.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant Luis Pacheco's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one (1) year in this State from the date of this judgment.
