

entered in the amount of \$7,512.50 against Defendant Harold W. Israel and in favor of the Plaintiff, Kenneth E. Kobylowski, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and

Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b for one (1) violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 et seq.; attorneys' fees of \$1,512.50 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.
