This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one (1) violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$3,031.50, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory insurance fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.
