This matter coming before the Court on the application of
Christopher S. Porrino, Attorney General, by Ryan S. Schaffer,
Deputy Attorney General, attorney for Plaintiff, Richard J.

Badolato, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance, for an Order of Summary Judgment against the Defendant, Elizabeth B. Smith, and the Court having considered the papers submitted, and for good cause shown; and

It is on this day of , 2017;


ORDERED, that Summary Judgment shall be and hereby is **GRANTED** in favor of the Plaintiff, Richard J. Badolato, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance, and against Defendant Elizabeth B. Smith; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that defendant, Elizabeth B. Smith, is adjudged liable for one violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 through -34; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that judgment shall be and hereby is entered in the amount of \$10,000.00 against Defendant Elizabeth B. Smith and in favor of the Plaintiff, Richard J. Badolato, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of: a \$2,500.00 civil penalty for one violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 et seq.; attorneys' fees of \$6,500.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A.
39:6A-15, Defendant Elizabeth B. Smith's driving privileges will
be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this
judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be
served on all parties within 7 days from the date hereof.
