This Court now finds that Defendant Sanchez-Munoz violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"), specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(b), by assisting and conspiring with another person to illegally refer

patients to receive medical treatment and to cause filing of insurance claims under the Personal Injury Protection benefits in an expectation of reimbursement for these illegal referrals;

entered in the amount of \$25,740.50 against Defendant, Andres Sanchez-Munoz, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$20,000.00 in civil penalties for four violations of the Fraud Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorneys' fees of \$4,740.50, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.
