Summary judgment is hereby granted in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant, Christina Iannotti.


Defendant shall pay the sum of \$5,000.00 to Plaintiff as a civil statutory penalty for one (1) violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b).

Defendant shall also pay \$7,054.00 in attorneys' fees to Plaintiff's counsel for all expenses incurred in litigation of this matter, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b).

Defendant shall also pay a \$1,000.00 statutory insurance fraud surcharge, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's New Jersey driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date hereof.
