**ORDER OF FINAL JUDGMENT BY

The Defendant, Cynthia Meyer ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-entitled action and having been defaulted for failure to appear, answer or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, specifically N.J.S.A.

17:33A-(a) (3), by knowingly providing false and misleading statements to Liberty Mutual Insurance Corp. ("Liberty Mutual") in support of collecting temporary total disability funds while she was earning a salary at the same time.

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 6th day of December, 2019, entered in the amount of \$67,897.26 against Defendant Meyer, and in favor of the Plaintiff, Commissioner of the State of New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of: \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$7,451.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and restitution in the amount of \$54,446.26 (\$52,982.00 principal plus prejudgment interest of \$1,464.26 payable to Liberty Mutual).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date of receipt.
