ORDER OF FINAL JUDGMENT
BY DEFAULT


Defendant, Matthew Dickinson, III ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-captioned action, and default having been entered for Defendant's failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1) and N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(4)(b). Specifically, Defendant knowingly provided materially false statements to

American Bankers Insurance Company of Florida ("American") by (i) falsely claiming on his application for insurance to American that he had not had any losses in the three years prior to his application, and (ii) falsely reporting to American the date damage occurred to his home.

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 14 day of February 2020, entered in the amount of \$13,750.00 against Defendant and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$10,000.00 in civil penalties for two (2) violations of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$2,685.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5; cost of service in the amount of \$65.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5; a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within _____ days of the date of receipt.
