THIS MATTER HAVING BEEN opened to the Court on the application of Gurbir S. Grewal, Attorney General of New Jersey, (by Eleanor Heck, Deputy Attorney General, appearing), attorney for Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance, for an Order of Final Judgment by Default; and

WHEREAS, the Defendant, Isaiah G. Colon, a/k/a Isaiah C. Colon, Isaiah C. Gainor, Isaiah Colon-Gainer, Isaiah C Colongainer, and Isaiah G. Colon-Gainer, has been duly

served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in this action and default having been entered for failure to appear, answer or otherwise defend;

This court now finds that Defendant, Isaiah G. Colon, violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 (the "Fraud Act"), specifically, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1), by knowingly providing false and misleading statements to Liberty Mutual Insurance Company in support of a property theft claim.

IT IS on this 26th day of October 2020,

ORDERED that FINAL JUDGMENT is entered in the amount of \$8,500.00 against Defendant, Isaiah G. Colon, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of: \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one violation of the Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$2,500.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); plus \$1,000.00 constituting the surcharge pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order be served on all parties within 7 days of the date hereof.
