AMENDED ORDER OF FINAL

BY DEFAULT

THIS MATTER HAVING BEEN opened to the Court on the application of Gurbir S. Grewal, Attorney General of New Jersey, (by Ashleigh B. Shelton, Deputy Attorney General, appearing), attorney for Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance on a motion for final judgment by default; and

The Defendants, Jeffrey Hill and Northeastern Pavement Technologies, LLC (collectively, "Defendants"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-entitled action and having been defaulted for failure to appear, answer or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendants violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"), specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(6), by altering and falsifying eleven certificates of insurance documents, and submitting such documents to various businesses to secure employment;

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 15th day of July 2021, entered in the amount of \$19,252.50 against Defendants, and in favor of the Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$11,000.00 in civil penalties for eleven violations of the Fraud Act at \$1,000.00 per violation pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; attorneys' fees of \$6,112.50 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; cost of service in the amount of \$140.00, jointly and severally, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 for each of the Defendants pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 5 days of the date of receipt.
