SUBJECT: New Jersey Care...Special Medicaid Programs; Expansion Reminder

Legislation in 1991 provided for an expansion of the New Jersey Care...Special Medicaid Programs to include children born after September 30, 1983, who have not attained the age of 19 and whose family's income is less than 100 percent of the federal poverty level. The effect of this legislation is a phase-in of the eligibility for older children.

Accordingly, effective October 1, 1995, coverage is available for all eligible children who are aged six through eleven and for those twelve-year-old children who became age twelve subsequent to September 30, 1995.
