Nursing facilities must file cost reports according to the schedule set forth in N.J.A.C. 8:85-3.2.

Processing timeframes:

Applications for the Statewide Respite Care program are processed by the provider agencies within 30 days. See N.J.A.C. 10:164B-3.1.
