

## Location & Regional Context




- Beverly City is part of the Route 130 Corridor.
  - > Located in the western portion of Burlington.
- Corridor extends approximately 16 miles.
- The combined area of the 12 municipalities is approximately 64 square miles.

## Location & Regional Context




- Approximately .75 square miles

- Bordering municipalities: Township of Delanco and Township of Edgewater Park



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#### Plan Endorsement




- The City of Beverly received Regional Center Designation on April 28, 1999.
- This designation was set to expire on June 30, 2020.
- The expiration has been extended through various extension approvals by the legislation, executive orders and/or SPC resolutions.
- The City is seeking Plan Endorsement to align its local planning goals and objectives with the State Plan and to make mapping changes consistent with resiliency and sustainable development practices and New Jersey State Planning Commission policies.



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## Planning & Implementation Agreement

- The Office of Planning Advocacy, Township of Brick, and our State Agency partners are in negotiations regarding the Plan and Implementation Agreement.
- It is expected that Beverly's Governing Body will formally approve the PIA and State proposed map at their October 25, 2022 meeting.
- The PIA includes items that OPA and our State Agencies believe will achieve consistency with the State
  Plan, as well as the updated Plan Endorsement Guidelines, which address State priorities for
  environmental justice and climate resiliency, including amendments to the New Jersey Municipal Land
  Use Law (MLUL).

#### Recommendation

Based on City of Beverly's continuing efforts in working with the State and Burlington County in achieving consistency with both the State Development and Redevelopment Plan and with the Burlington County Plan, it is recommended that City of Beverly move forward to the State Planning Commission (SPC) to be awarded their Plan Endorsement inclusive of the proposed mapping.
