

This permit is subject to the following **SPECIFIC CONDITIONS**:

1. The operations of the public water facility shall be under the supervision of an operator or operators who shall possess a valid license or licenses issued by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Supply and Wastewater Operators' Licensing Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11-64 et seq.; The minimum required licensing classification(s) shall be W-2 and T-1 or equivalent and in accordance with the Licensing of Water Supply and Wastewater Treatment System Operators, N.J.A.C. 7:10A-1.1 et seq., and the supplements thereof and amended thereto; *and*
2. The public water facilities shall be operated in such a manner so as to be in full compliance with the New Jersey Safe Drinking Water Act Rules at N.J.A.C. 7:10-1.1 et seq. and the Water Supply Management Act Rules at N.J.A.C. 7:19-1.1 et seq.;

This permit is subject to the following **GENERAL CONDITIONS**:

1. The permit is revocable, or subject to modification or change, at any time, when in the judgment of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection such revocation, modification or change shall be necessary.
2. The issuance of this permit shall not be deemed to affect in any way action by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection on any future application.
3. The works, facilities and/or activities shown by plans and/or other engineering data, which are this day approved, subject to the conditions herewith established, shall be constructed and/or executed in conformity with such plans and/or engineering data and said conditions.
4. No change in plans or specifications shall be made without prior written permission from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.
5. The granting of this permit shall not be construed in any way to affect the title or ownership of property, and shall not make the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection or the State a party in any suit or question of ownership of property.
6. This permit does not waive the obtaining of Federal or other State or local Government consent when necessary. This permit is not valid and no work shall be undertaken until such time as all other required approvals and permits have been obtained.
7. A copy of this permit shall be kept at the work site, and shall be exhibited upon request of any person.
8. In the examination of plans and/or other engineering data, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection does not examine the structural features of the design, such as thickness of concrete or its reinforcement, the efficiency of any electrical or mechanical equipment or apparatus; and the approval herewith given does not include these features.
9. Water distribution by said works shall at all times meet the applicable standards for quality. Additional units for the derivation, treatment and for distribution of the water shall be established if and when required by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.
10. For this permit to remain valid, the facilities approved in this permit shall be constructed and placed into service within three (3) years from the effective date of the permit. Within 30 days of completion of the approved facilities the permittee/engineer shall notify the Department of the completion date and certify that the facilities were constructed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications.

The Land Use Regulation Program has reviewed the referenced application for a Statewide General Permit and a Special Activity Waiver authorization pursuant to the requirements of the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act Rules at N.J.A.C. 7:7A. This letter of authorization to conduct a regulated activity in a wetland or open water includes a Water Quality Certificate for these activities.

Statewide General Permit

Limit of Authorized Disturbance

Based on plans entitled "NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, DRAINAGE PLANS, ENVIRONMENTAL PLANS, ROUTE 46 CONTRACT NO. 055960382, ROUTE U.S. 46 / FAIRFIELD ROAD IMPROVEMENTS," sheet 14 and 15, dated November 28, 2000, unrevised, and prepared by T&M Associates, Inc., the authorized activity involves the disturbance of 0.026 of an acre of wetlands and associated transition area for the reconstruction of Fairfield Road under a Statewide General Permit No. 10. Any additional disturbance of freshwater wetlands, State open waters or transition area shall be considered a violation of the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act unless the activity is exempt or a permit is obtained prior to the start of the disturbance from the Land Use Regulation Program.

Permit Conditions

The activities allowed by this authorization shall comply with the following conditions. Failure to comply with these conditions shall constitute a violation of the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act (N.J.S.A. 13:9B-1 et seq.).

General conditions

- All fill and other earth work on the lands encompassed within this permit authorization shall be stabilized in accordance with "Standards for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control in New Jersey" to prevent eroded soil from entering adjacent waterways or wetlands at any time during and subsequent to construction.

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Authorization for Statewide General Permit and  
Special Activity Waiver

2. This permit is revocable, or subject to modification or change at any time, when in judgement of the Department of Environmental Protection of the State of New Jersey, such revocation, modification or change shall be necessary.
3. The issuance of this permit shall not be deemed to affect in any way other actions by the Department on any future application.
4. The activities shown by plans and/or other engineering data, which are this day approved, subject to the conditions herewith established, shall be constructed and/or executed in conformity with such plans and/or engineering data and the said conditions.
5. No change in plans or specifications shall be made except with the prior written permission of the Department.
6. The granting of this authorization shall not be construed to affect the title or ownership of the property, and shall not make the Department or the State a party in any suit or question of ownership of the property.
7. This authorization is not valid and no work shall be undertaken until such time as all other required approvals and permits have been obtained.
8. A copy of this authorization shall be kept at the work site and shall be exhibited upon request of any person.

Waiver of Transition Area

The Land Use Regulation Program has determined the wetlands affected by the Statewide General Permit and Special Activity Waiver are of intermediate resource value. The wetlands have also been designated as priority wetlands by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. This classification may affect the requirements for an Individual Wetlands Permit and Open Water Fill Permits (see N.J.A.C. 7:7A-3), the types of Statewide General Permits available for the wetlands portion of this property (see N.J.A.C. 7:7A-9) and the modification available through the transition area waiver (see N.J.A.C. 7:7A-7). Please refer to the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act (N.J.S.A.13:9B-1 et seq.) and implementing rules for additional information.

Any additional prohibited activities conducted within the standard transition area on-site shall require a separate transition area waiver from the Program. Prohibited activities within a transition area are defined at N.J.A.C. 7:7A-6.2(a).

Special Activity Waiver - Statewide General Permit No. 10

The submitted plans show the modification of this standard transition area through the means of a special activity waiver. The proposed activity, the reconstruction and improvement to Fairfield Road and Route US 46, is authorized by a special activity waiver Statewide General Permit No. 10.

Waiver Conditions

In addition to the standard conditions set forth in section 7:7A-7.3, the following special conditions must be met:

Authorization for Statewide General Permit and  
Special Activity Waiver

1. The transition area shall not be reduced to less than 5 feet in width, as shown on the referenced plan.

Failure to comply with these conditions shall constitute a violation of the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act (N.J.S.A. 13:9B-1 et seq). This determination does not affect your responsibility to obtain any local, State, or Federal permits, which may be required.

The freshwater wetlands and waters boundary line(s) and the transition area boundary line, as determined in this letter must be shown on any future site development plans. The line(s) should be labeled with the above LURP file number and the following note:

"Freshwater Wetlands/Transition Area Boundary Line as approved by NJDEP"

This authorization for a Statewide General Permit and Special Activity Waiver is valid for a term not to exceed five years from the date of this letter. If the term of the authorization exceeds the expiration date of the general permit and special activity waiver issued by rule, and the permit upon which the authorization is based is modified by rule to include more stringent standards or conditions, or is not reissued, the applicant must comply with the requirements of the new regulations by applying for a new GP and special activity waiver authorization or an Individual permit.

The permittee shall allow an authorized Program representative the right to inspect the construction site. The permittee will notify, in writing, Coastal and Land Use Enforcement at 401 East State Street, 4th Floor, P.O. Box 422, Trenton, NJ 08625 at least 7 days prior to commencement of work authorized by this letter.


Appeal of Decision
