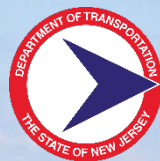

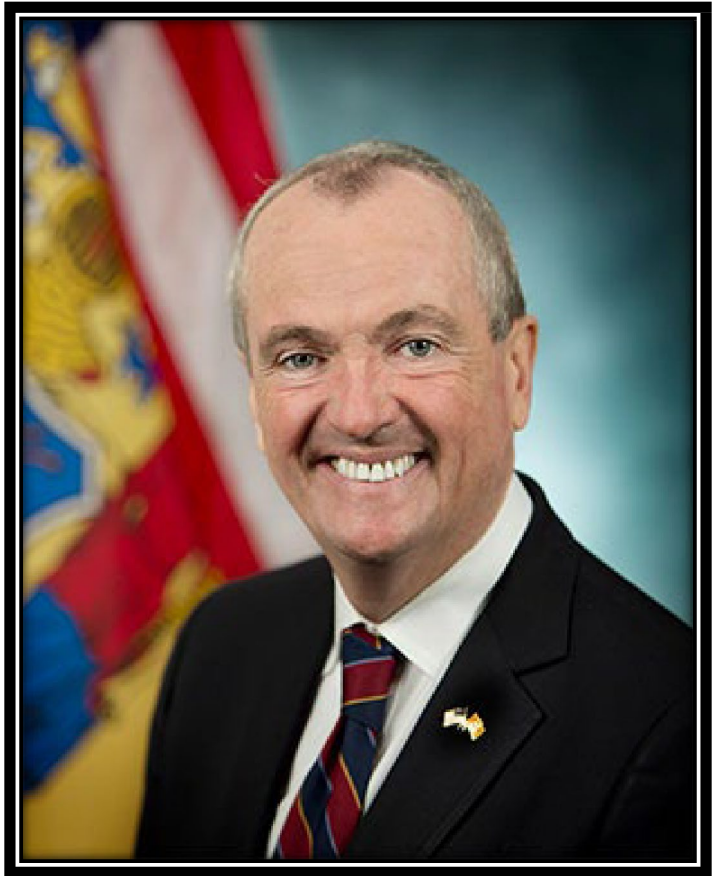

A MESSAGE FROM GOVERNOR PHILIP D. MURPHY

The New Jersey Airport Directory has been updated to serve as a convenient general resource for all who are involved in the aviation industry, including pilots, recreational and business travelers, and the business that support New Jersey's airport system. Each of our airports, from the turf landing strips at Red Wing Airport to the bustling Newark Liberty International airport, are vital components of New Jersey's multimodal transportation network, and all play a part in promoting economic activity by contributing jobs and general revenue.

New Jersey is a national leader in aviation history dating back to 1910, when Bader Field opened in Atlantic City, seven years after the Wright Brother's first flight. The City of Newark built an airport, now known as the Newark Liberty International Airport, with the first hard surface runway on August 28, 1928 and in 1930 boasted the first control tower in the United States. During World War II Millville Airport, Woodbine Airport, Trenton-Mercer Airport and Linden Airport were used for pilot training and military aircraft manufacturing.

The Ocean City Municipal Airport is the only airport located on a New Jersey barrier island where you can land, walk to the beach, go for a swim, and take off again. The Teterboro Airport, just 12 miles from Midtown Manhattan, is consistently one of the busiest general aviation airports in the country and a preferred airport for the pilots and passengers of private planes and corporate jets heading to New York City.

The availability of multiple air travel options is essential in a state as densely populated as New Jersey. The current state airport system helps New Jersey compete successfully for corporations seeking to relocate and to enable tourists to explore our great attractions. With multiple airports offering commercial flights, it's easy for visitors to arrive at their destination, no matter where that might be.

A MESSAGE FROM COMMISSIONER DIANE GUTIERREZ-SCACCETTI

Through the Bureau of Aeronautics, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) fosters the development of an efficient air transportation system. The Department is dedicated to preventing air accidents and incidents and providing safe air facilities at New Jersey's public use airports through consistent inspections. The Department oversees the licensing of public use airports, heliports, and balloon ports, and keeps the public informed of activation news and events. Additionally, the Department promotes aviation safety and provides information about aviation grants available for airport infrastructure improvements.

This recently updated New Jersey Airport Directory provides information regarding the 41 public use airports located in the 21 counties of New Jersey and is a comprehensive list of the activation facilities in the State. This directory is available in print and electronic formats. It includes maps, specific information on the capabilities of each airport and services available at each landing facility. Enhanced updates to this directory to benefit the New Jersey flying community include an airport diagram, 30-minute drive time map created for each individual airport, and aerial imagery that features runway numbers clearly displayed on both ends as well as a north arrow.

New Jersey's airport system is one of the most unique and complex in the United States. The State's 41 diverse public use airports range in size from small privately owned general aviation airports with turf runways in rural locations to the Newark Liberty International Airport, one of the nation's busiest urban commercial flight operation airports. Among these airports, three are classified by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) as primary commercial service airports, thirteen are classified as reliever airports and the remainder are classified as general aviation airports. More than half of these airports are privately owned with the balance of ownership by state, county, city, or local jurisdictions.

I trust that you will enjoy your flying experience in New Jersey. Please fly safe and may all your flying be with ceilings and visibly unlimited (CAVU), and a tailwind in both directions.

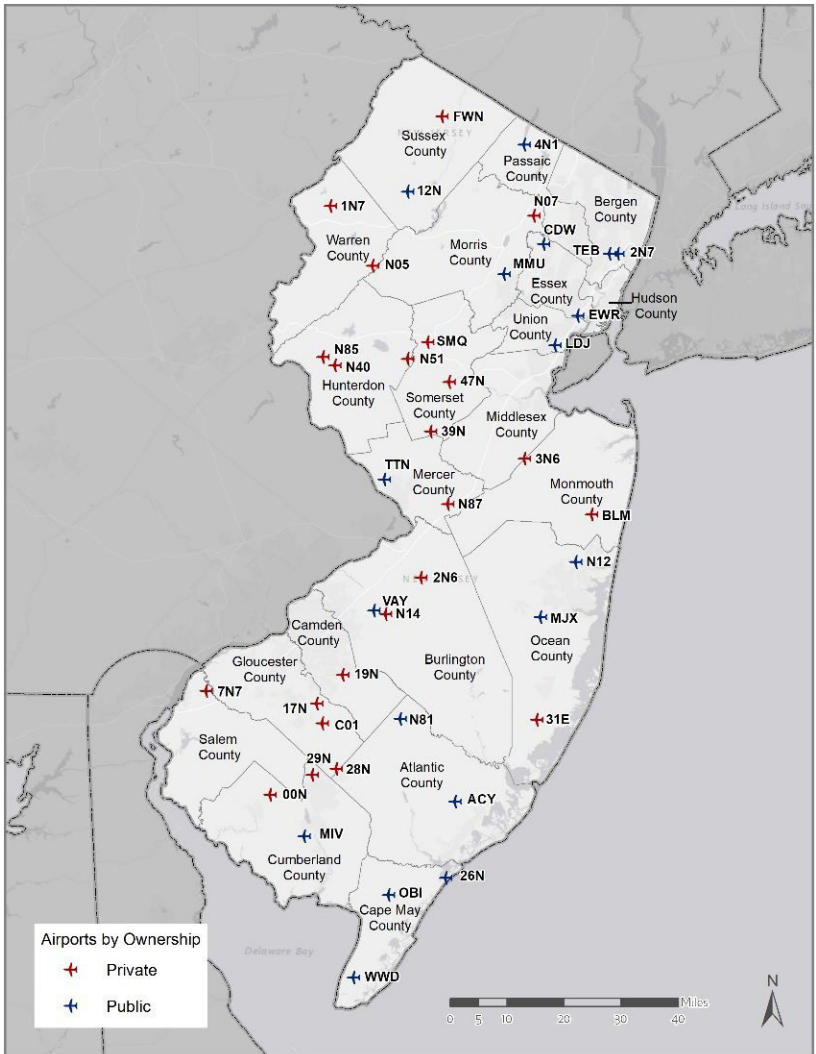

Statewide Airport Map

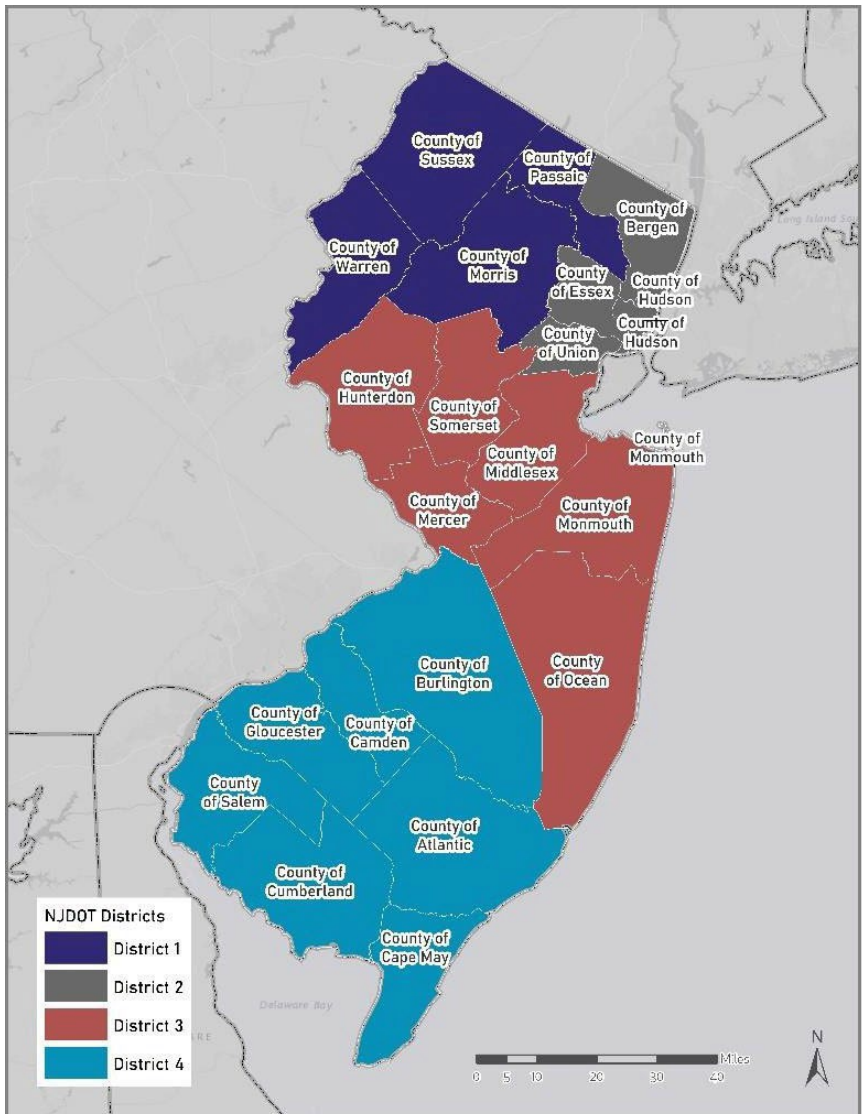

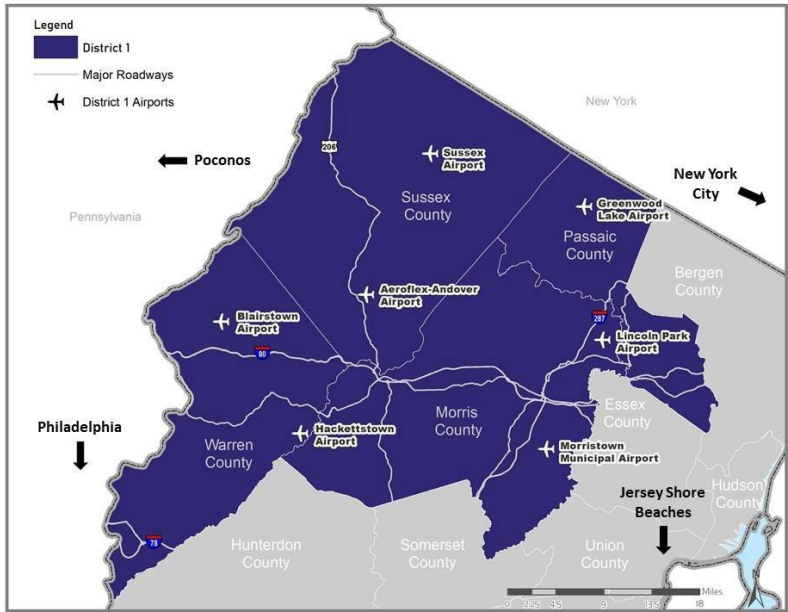

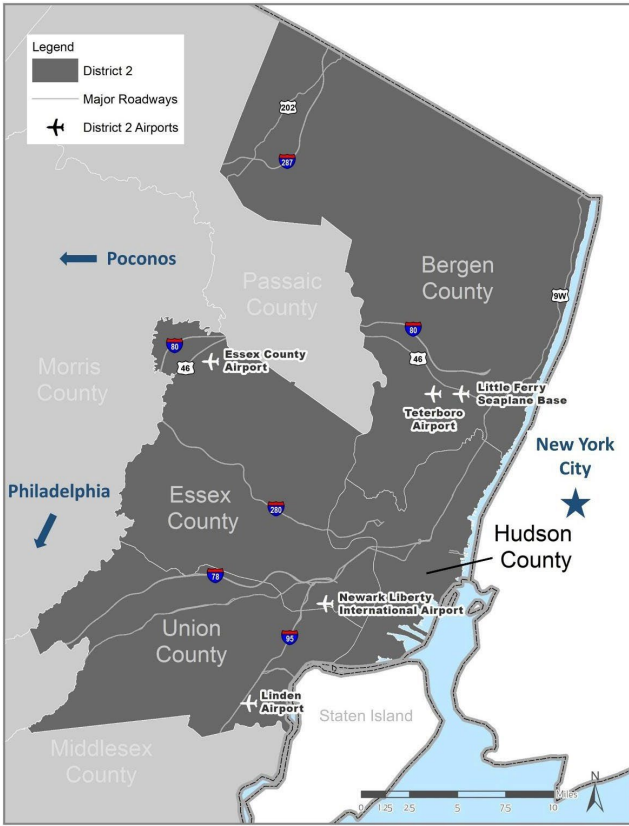

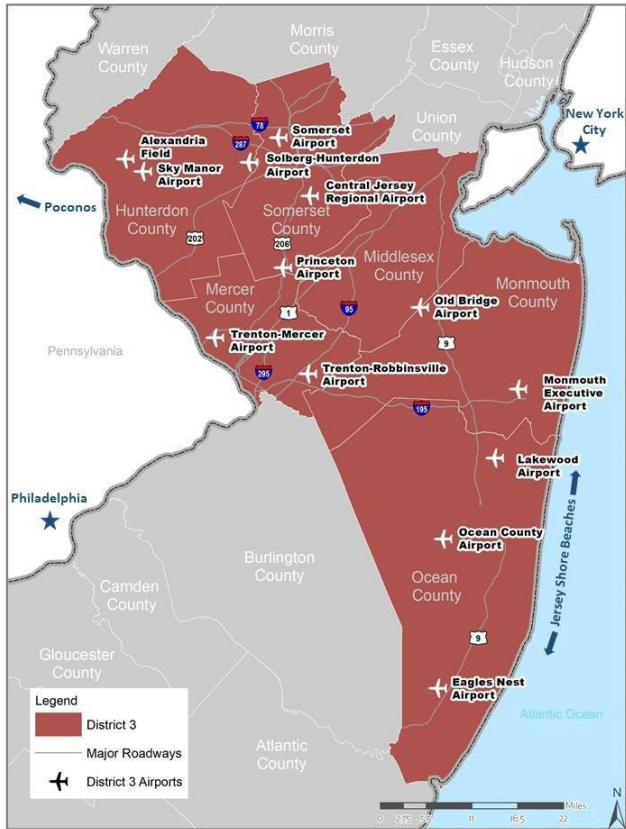

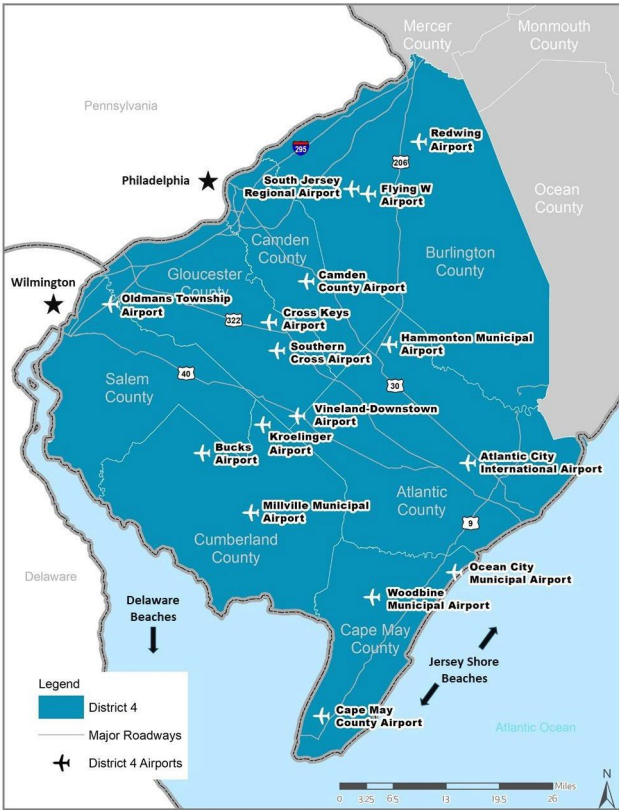
