RESOLUTION

Recognizing the Month of September, 2014 as "Recovery Month" in New Jersey

September 17, 2014

WHEREAS, Recovery Month is a national observance that educates Americans on the fact that addiction treatment and mental health services can enable those with a mental and/or substance use disorder to live a healthy and rewarding life; and

WHEREAS, Recovery Month promotes the societal benefits of prevention, treatment and recovery for mental and substance use disorders, celebrates people in recovery and promotes the message that recovery in all its forms is possible; and

WHEREAS, there are millions of Americans whose lives have been transformed through recovery but whose success at overcoming an addiction or mental health disorder often go unnoticed by the broader population; and
